

The Wilderness Bike Tour - MOUNTAIN BIKE RIDE *(Helmets Required)*

28K ride on Agonikak Trail from LOL to Watersmeet Trailhead and Return.

This is an up and back ride on the Agonikak National Recreation Trail on Ottawa National Forest Land

Special Note: The Southern 2 miles of the trail are temporarily inaccessible due to a logging operation, so the southern 2 miles will follow a paved secondary road, South Moon Lake Road. An escort vehicle or rider will be provided to reach the trail.

1. Leave from State Line Events Center and follow an escort 2 miles to the trail
2. Ride to the Watersmeet Trailhead. You can bike 1 mile from the Watersmeet Trailhead to the Ottawa National Forest Visitor Center for water and bathrooms or bike 2 miles to Watersmeet to purchase food and beverage.
3. Ride from the Watersmeet Trailhead back to State Line Catering in Land O' Lakes
4. An alternate return route from the Watersmeet Trailhead on a multiple use trail (former Railroad Bed) is available. This route passes by the Ottawa National Forest Visitor Center where water and bathrooms are available.

This route has some areas (less than 10%) with loose sand and cobblestones, but is quite scenic, with 5 bridge crossings over pristine Duck Creek, a local Trout Stream. It is possible to encounter some light ATV or 4WD traffic

Note: Transportation from Watersmeet Trailhead to Land O' Lakes will be available for any riders that had intended on riding back to Land O' Lakes, but decide they cannot or don't want to take the return bike trip. Note: this will not be available if no one has registered for the 14K ride described below

14K ride on Agonikak Trail from Watersmeet to State Line Catering in Land O' Lakes. Transportation for riders and bikes from Land O' Lakes to Watersmeet Trail head **available with pre-registration.**

Purchased Food and Drink Options for Mountain Bike Ride

You can detour a short distance from the Watersmeet Trailhead to the town of Watersmeet where you can purchase ice cream, food, or beverages at Strong's Restaurant, Big Mama's Restaurant, or at Nordine's Grocery Store and Amoco Station.

Food After the Ride in Land O' Lakes

1. You can find Brats and Hamburgers at the Airport Fly-in from 10AM until noon. The Airport is about ½ mile south of Stateline Events Center, behind the Gateway Lodge.
2. Brats and Hamburgers will also be available at the Art Impressions Art and Craft Show after noon. The Art Impressions Art and Craft Show is 1 mile west of Stateline Events Center, or 1 mile before the finish of the Road Ride and the Paved Bike Trail Ride.
3. "1938 North" is a restaurant located inside the Gateway and has a full food and beverage menu.
4. The Rusty Nail Tavern, ½ mile west of Stateline Events Center, has burgers and beverages
5. Donaldson's Gourmet, ½ mile west of Stateline Events Center has a Coffee House.
6. The Dairy Maid 1 mile west of Stateline Catering has all sorts of soft serve ice cream treats, drinks and food
