

The Wilderness Bike Tour - PAVED BIKE TRAIL RIDE (*Helmets Required*)

Paved Bike Trail Ride

Up to 16 miles(26K) bike on Paved Land O' Lakes Trail. *Ride any distance you want up to 26K.*

1. Start at State Line Catering and follow Escort Vehicle for the first mile. The Escort will allow for safer travel through town and congestion due to the Art Impressions Art and Craft Show that day.
2. The second mile is in a bike lane along County Highway B after which the trail separates from the road.
3. Bike 8 miles west to the end of the trail at the Forest Lake Country Store and return, or choose to turn around sooner and return. This is an “up and back” bike trail, ideally suited for families.

Purchased Food and Drink Options for the Paved Bike Trail Ride

1. The Country Store sells Ice Cream, food, and beverages, including a wide selection of Wine and Beer to consume or take back in your pack.
2. The Dairy Maid, 1 mile west of Stateline Events Center, has all sorts of soft serve ice cream treats, drinks and food
3. Donaldson's Gourmet, ½ mile west of Stateline Events Center, has a Coffee House.

Food After the Ride in Land O' Lakes

1. You can find Brats and Hamburgers at the Airport Fly-in from 10AM until noon. The Airport is about ½ mile south of Stateline Events Center, behind the Gateway Lodge
2. Brats and Hamburgers will also be available at the Art Impressions Art and Craft Show after noon. The Art Impressions Art and Craft Show is 1 mile west of Stateline Catering, or 1 mile before the finish of the Road Ride and the Paved Bike Trail Ride.
3. "1938 North" is a restaurant located in the Gateway Lodge and has a full lunch and beverage menu.
4. The Rusty Nail Tavern, ½ mile west of Stateline Events Center, has burgers and beverages
